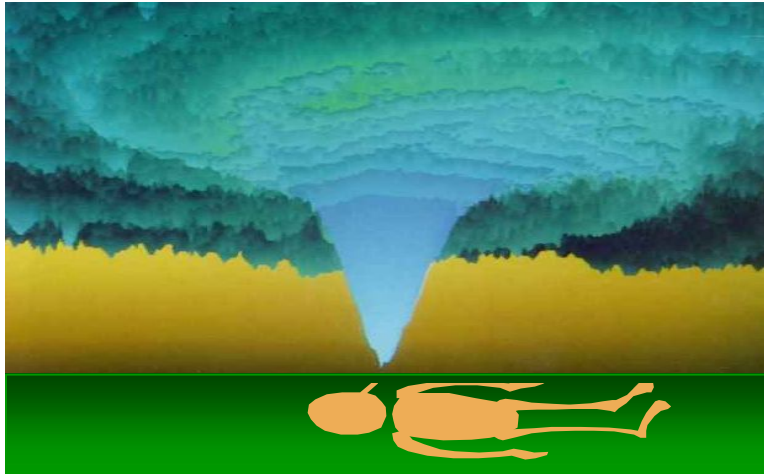


## THE BREATH OF GOD
